Ungarelli and Damren said that in addition to forming the Lebanon Public Libraries Foundation (LPLF) to oversee private donations, the trustees and the 33-member Kilton Public Library Building Committee have been fine-tuning the overall design with the architects since last summer.

Officials also hired Burlington-based consultant Christine Graham, who studied the feasibility of a campaign to raise private funds. Graham

did a similar study, including interviews of town residents, for Hanover's Howe Library renovations and expansion, and for a project at Burlington's Fletcher Free Library.

"Fund raising for a library is different from other nonprofits," Graham said last week. "Generally, the whole community feels a sense of responsibility for this kind of project, even people who don't generally go to the library. They understand the value of a library."
